Warm greetings, Parkway Family!

As COVID-19 cases continue to surge in Missouri, our Parkway United Church of Christ Council and staff are developing guidelines for building usage. Our purpose is to protect our Parkway Family—including you, staff and community groups that use our building.

For now and the foreseeable future, we will continue with online worship only. We are providing many opportunities for remote connection via ZOOM which are listed on our church calendar each week: <https://parkwayucc.org/calendar/> Please stay connected. We welcome new ideas as well!

The church office remains closed. Please do not enter the building until further notice. All staff are available via email. The church answering machine is also checked several times per weekday. Our *Care Team* continues to be active. Please contact Kevin if we can help you in any way. He is setting up August/September visits via phone, zoom or outdoor social distancing on church grounds. Look for more information and a link to sign up later this week. [This mirrors *Summer Visits* from the past—a *no agenda* time to check-in and pray together.]

We are working with a few tenants that are continuing to meet—and others resuming meeting. Several of our community partners are opting not to return to Parkway UCC until a later time. We are requiring all to abide by all current state/local and CDC guidelines as well as a few additional guidelines we have put in place specifically for PUCC. Our custodial service is currently only onsite twice per week cleaning designated areas.

All users of the building are following these mandatory guidelines:

- Self-screening process—if anyone is sick or has tested positive for the coronavirus within a two-week period, they may not enter. Likewise, if they have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for the virus, they may not enter the building for two weeks.
- Wearing masks.
- Signing in so we know who is in the building—in case contact tracing becomes necessary.
- Social distancing of at least six feet between persons.
- In emergencies only, the restrooms in the Education Wing are available.
